TO MARCH 31, 1872, INCLUSIVE.

THE Trustees, pursuant to the By-law on the subject, submit the following as their annual Report of the condition of this Institution at the close of the fiscal year, on the 31st of March, 1872.

REPORT.

AT the termination of the fiscal year at the date above specified, the Board appointed a special committee to audit the accounts of the Treasurer during the year then just closed; and this Committee, having discharged the duty intrusted to them, in conformity with the directions of the By-law relating to such annual accounting, made their report, in which the results of their examination are stated, as will appear on reference to their statement, and to the Treasurer's account current, which form part of this report; showing in general the value of the Real Estate of this Corporation, and the correctness of the Treasurer's accounts.

The Library Committee (which consists of four members of the Board, appointed by the Trustees; and also of the Treasurer and Secretary, who are ex-officio joint members of the same Committee) are specially intrusted by the By-laws with the care and management of the Library and Reading

Room. They purchase the Books, Pamphlets, and Papers selected for the use of these Rooms ; audit the accounts against this Corporation, transact all ordinary business not requiring the special action of the Board of Trustees ; have the power to enforce the rules for the regulation of the Library and Reading Room ; and at each monthly stated meeting of the Board, report, by the reading of their minutes during the intervening monthly period. These minutes are then approved, amended, referred back, or otherwise acted upon, according to the judgment of the Trustees. When so approved, the minutes are considered as the action of the Board, in all matters embraced therein.

The extent of the purchases of Books for the Library is restricted to the actual balance of cash on hand, in excess of the amount required for current expenses.

The duty of the Librarian is made specially obligatory in regard to all purchases of Books for the Library. He is required to keep a full and accurate Catalogue of all Books belonging to the Library ; which Catalogue shall contain an entry of the Title of every book, etc., from time to time added to the Library. An abridged list of these additions made during the current year is hereto likewise annexed to the Report now submitted for the information of the stockholders, as also for others who take an interest in the subject and in the welfare of the Institution.

It is expected that in the course of a few months the new Catalogue, now in course of preparation, will be ready for distribution ; a circumstance which is a subject of congratulation to all who have a direct interest in the matter ; as well as to those who desire to ascertain the character and extent of the Library.

It seems proper, in conclusion, to mention in connection with the above particulars, that a separate Report, with the consent of the Trustees, will be submitted to the shareholders, for their consideration ; containing the views of the Chairman in relation to the means, in his judgment, believed to be highly desirable in order to render the Institution of greater utility to the community.

THE Committee appointed to "audit the accounts of this Corporation, and to make an inventory of all its real and personal property," etc., respectfully report :—

That they have examined the accounts of the Treasurer for the year ending March 31, 1872, compared the expenditures with the vouchers, and find the same to be correct.

The balance remaining in the hands of the Treasurer to the credit of the Corporation on the 1st day of April, 1872 (exclusive of the amount to the credit of the Commutation fund), is \$1,435.26.

More than the whole of this balance is due to the Commutation fund, and as much thereof as the exigencies of the Library permit will be invested by the Treasurer and carried to the credit of that fund.

Regulations.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for annual payments, fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept 6 weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week. Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed 1 week longer. A Book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid.

No member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
