ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
TRUSTEES
OF THE
NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit for the information of the shareholders in this Institution, the following brief statement of the condition of its affairs at the close of the present year.

The Report made by the Treasurer for this year ending April the 1st, 1881, furnishes evidence of the condition of the Institution, and the Report of the Committee, charged with examining the accounts of the Treasurer, to be found in connection with this Report, exhibits a statement of the property of the Library, and how the same is invested.

We are happy to state that the hope expressed in the last Annual Report, "That the increased income would enable the Library Committee to make larger additions than heretofore," has been realized. There has been a greater demand for books, particularly for works of a higher standard.

Our income, largely increased by the gifts and legacies received, enables us now to meet that demand, and it only needs the continuance of the generous benefactions of its friends to place the Institution on a basis worthy of its history and standing.

The liberal bequest by the late Mrs. Mary M. Keese of \$12,000 was received too late to be acknowledged in the last annual report of the Trustees.

The "John C. Green Fund" of \$50,000 has produced a net income over all expenses of four per cent., nearly all of which has been expended, one-half for works on art for the "John C. Green Alcove," and the other half for books for circulation. The income from this fund for the ensuing fiscal year will amount to not less than six per cent. over and above taxes and all expenses.

Since the first of January last the "John C. Green Alcove" has been constantly kept open, an attendant having been employed for that purpose, and its usefulness and attractions have been greatly enhanced thereby.

The attendance for the receipt and delivery of books, heretofore much less than in any other library of its size and circulation, has been increased by the employment of an additional assistant.

On the whole, the present condition and future prospects of this ancient corporation can be confidently pronounced to be in a much more satisfactory and promising condition than for many years before.

The Committee appointed to "audit the accounts of this corporation, and to make an inventory of its real and personal property, excepting the books," etc., respectfully report :

That they have examined the accounts of the Treasurer for the year ending March 31, 1881, compared the expenditures with the vouchers, and find the same to be correct.

The balance remaining to the credit of the corporation in banks on the first day of April, 1881, is \$7,741.42, of which \$6,441 is drawing interest at the rate of four per cent.

The Committee have also examined the securities which constitute the estate, and estimate the value of the property (books excepted) as follows :

The fund known as the "John C. Green Fund," amounting to \$50,000, is included in the amount of the value of said Chatham and Worth Streets property.

The Institution has no debts.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Folios may be kept 6 weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week. Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed 1 week longer. A Book may be again taken out, unless another Member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.
