ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the members of the Corporation the following report of its affairs and condition, during the year ending March 31st, 1887.

From the report of the Treasurer, which is also herewith submitted, it will be seen that—

Of the balance of income from the "Green Memorial Fund" the sum of \$1,432.96, is set apart for the purchase of books for the "Green Alcove," and \$440.98 are available for the purchase of works of general literature, excluding prose fiction.

The number of volumes added to the Library during the past year is 1,137, of which number 292 are works of fiction in English, French, German and Italian; a decrease of works of fiction added, as compared with last year, of 197 volumes.

There has been a considerable increase in the number of books of all kinds drawn from the Library during the past year, while the percentage of works of fiction circulated has slightly decreased. May we not hope that this is an indication of a proper appreciation of the intent and scope of this Library.

The Reading Room has been more frequented than during the preceding year, by both ladies and gentlemen, and there has been a decided increase in the number of temporary subscribers.

Printed lists of new additions have been sent to the members and subscribers from time to time, and it is possible that the increased use of the Library has been promoted thereby.

The Library is still frequented by special students for consultation of authorities, and the "Green Alcove" is sought by the lovers of art and artistic workers for the valuable works in their special department, which it contains.

The Trustees take pleasure in stating that the funds of the Library are safely and profitably invested, for which they refer to the Report of the Treasurer and the Auditing Committee.

The same economical administration of the Library is continued, and no changes have been made during the year in the persons employed or in the salaries paid.

The Trustees have given much consideration to the subject of establishing a branch office in the upper part of the city. They are fully aware of the increased convenience such a branch would afford to many of the members, and of the possibility by this means of a considerable addition to the number of its members and subscribers. But the cost of such an experiment would be considerable, and the Committee having the matter in charge and the Trustees did not deem it prudent with the limited means of the Library to make the attempt at present.

Persons not Members or Subscribers have the privilege of consultation by the payment of 25 cents.

Regulations.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week.

Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
