ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit the following report of its affairs and condition at the close of the year ending March 31st, 1888.

From the report of the Treasurer herewith submitted, it will be seen that—

The receipts from all sources, including the balance brought over	
from last year, amount to.....	\$15,864.82
Of which there were received from rents and interest.....	6,200.56
From annual dues and temporary subscriptions.....	4,406.50
The balance on hand in the Treasury is, in the general fund and avail-	
able for the regular ordinary expenses of the Library.....	3,367.56
In the "Green Memorial Fund".....	2,350.38

Of the balance of income from the "Green Memorial Fund" the sum of \$1,831.47 is set apart for the purchase of books for the "Green Alcove," and \$518.91 are available for the purchase of works of general literature, excluding prose fiction.

The whole of the Park Row (late Chatham St.) property has now been leased for a term of 21 years, and yields a net income of nearly eight per cent. upon the whole investment, besides all taxes and assessments.

The Trustees are happy to report that the tax of \$864 which had been assessed upon the property occupied by the Library has been cancelled.

The number of volumes added to the Library during the past year is 1,117, and the number of books circulated, as well as that of members frequenting the Library and Reading Room, has been larger than in the preceding year.

The Trustees have sought in the purchase of books, to supply such works as are called for by the members, and are likely to be read, rather than to accumulate a large number of volumes; and it is proposed that the increased means of the Library shall be devoted to larger purchases of the best editions of standard works, and of such as are needed to supply deficiencies in various departments.

The experience of other Library Associations in maintaining branches, even in favorable locations, has not proved satisfactory, and fully justifies the caution of

the Trustees in hesitating to incur the large expense of establishing a branch of this Institution at present, but it is worthy of consideration whether a systematic plan for delivering books throughout the city might not be attempted.

The causes affecting the prosperity of all shareholding and subscription libraries—such as the establishment of large free libraries, the cheapness of the popular publication of the day; the great increase in the number of Clubs and other Associations possessing libraries and reading rooms of their own, combined with social attractions—all the growth of the last few years, have impeded the growth and prosperity of other public libraries as well as our own.

But the New York Society Library is peculiarly fitted from its history and position, to supply a want that will always be felt in a large and wealthy city and it only needs larger endowments to adapt itself to the changed circumstances in which it is placed and meet the requirements of its shareholders.

The Trustees have continued with beneficial results, sending to members and subscribers occasional printed lists of additions to the library, and "The Green Alcove" forms a constantly increasing attraction to special students and artistic workers for the valuable works it contains.

The economical administration of the library continues, and no changes have been made during the past year in the persons employed.

The Trustees cannot close this report without referring to the death of Mr. Robert Lenox Kennedy, for more than thirty years a Trustee of the Library, and its liberal benefactor.

The minutes adopted by the Trustees on the occasion of Mr. Kennedy's death, is herewith printed.

MR. ROBERT LENOX KENNEDY, whose recent removal from us by death we deeply feel, has been for many years one of the most useful and honored Trustees of this Institution, ever showing his attachment to it by acts of generous liberality. Through his efforts the largest endowment the Library has received was procured, and to this he made contributions from time to time from his own means. His exquisite taste in art made him a most servicable counsellor in the selection of works in that department, and to him the Society owes the Green Alcove and its precious contents. His integrity of character, uniform courtesy of manner, and considerate regard for the feelings of others endeared him to his associates, though his extreme modesty deterred him from accepting the chairmanship of the Library to which he was repeatedly invited, and which he was so well qualified to fill.

The Trustees of the N. Y. Society Library, as an expression of the sense of their great loss, which they share with so many of the Religious, Charitable, and Literary Institutions of the city, and of their respect and regard for their late associate, direct the entry of this minute in the record of their proceedings.

Regulations.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos three weeks, octavos two weeks, duodecimos one week.

Members residing more than ten miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
